

2022 IA 1040 TAX TABLES For All Filing Statuses

To find your tax: Read down the left column until you find the range for your Iowa taxable income from line 38 on form IA 1040.

Read across to the column marked "Your Tax Is." Enter the amount on line 39.

TAXABLE INCOME OVER \$95,800

If line 38 exceeds \$95,800, multiply the excess over \$95,775 by 8.53% (.0853) and add it to \$6,079.00. Enter the total on line 39 of the IA 1040. Round your total.

EXAMPLE

If line 38 of IA 1040 = \$110,000

STEP 1

\$110,000 - \$95,775 = \$14,225

STEP 2

\$14,225 x 8.53% = \$1,213.39

STEP 3

\$1,213.39 + \$6,079 = \$7,292.39 (round to \$7,292)

Enter \$7,292 on line 39 of the IA 1040.
