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IOWA INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX SCHOOL DISTRICT REPORT TAX YEAR 2020

This annual report contains information concerning individual income tax for residents of each school district in the state during 2020 and an estimate of each district's surtax base. School districts are listed under the county in which their administration offices are located.

Estimation of Surtax

The surtax base represents Iowa individual income tax liability after the application of nonrefundable Iowa tax credits but prior to the application of other refundable credits. It is equal to line 53 of the 2020 IA 1040.

The surtax base is not the same as net individual income tax liability as reported in the Iowa Department of Revenue's Individual Income Tax Annual Statistical Report. For that report, net tax liability is defined as line 53 of the 2020 IA 1040 less the refundable credits on lines 59-62.

Iowa tax law requires that nonresidents and part-year residents report income from Iowa and non-Iowa sources even though only income from Iowa sources is taxed. For this report, some of the non-Iowa source income is included in the income measures presented for school districts in the case of taxpayers who moved into a school district during 2020 but also had income from outside the state. Thus, while the surtax base for each district is correct, the income for the district may be somewhat overstated. Tax information concerning nonresidents and part-year residents with no school district reported on the tax return is included separately in this report.

Glossary of Terms Used in this Report

Adjusted Gross Income - Gross income minus specified deductions, reported on line 26 of the 2020 IA 1040.

Taxable Income - Income subject to tax after adjustment for net federal tax payments and itemized or standard deductions, reported on line 38 of the 2020 IA 1040.

Number of Taxpayers - Total number of returns filed, with married taxpayers filing separately on a combined return counted as two taxpayers.

Personal and Dependent Credits - The number of credits claimed in step 3 of the 2020 IA 1040. One personal credit is allowed for each taxpayer, plus one for a spouse on joint returns. One additional personal credit may be claimed by unmarried heads of households, as well as by taxpayers who are age 65 or older or blind. One dependent credit is allowed for each qualified dependent in the household.

Surtax Base - State income tax owed after nonrefundable tax credits but before refundable tax credits, reported on line 53 of the 2020 IA 1040. This is the tax base to which a surtax rate can be applied in order to estimate the amount of surtax that could be collected in a school district.
