What is the intended benefit of the rule?

Chapter 531—13 is intended to provide generally applicable rules that outline the responsibilities of retailers licensed by the Iowa Lottery to sell lottery products. These rules further the Lottery's goal of developing and maintaining a network of retailers across the state who serve the public convenience and promote the sale of the Lottery's products while ensuring integrity of the Lottery's operations and games.

Is the benefit being achieved? Please provide evidence.

Yes. In 2023, the Iowa Lottery's network of retailers continued to expand across the state. These rules outline the responsibilities of licensed retailers and facilitate the retail sale of lottery products.

What are the costs incurred by the public to comply with the rule?

Under these rules, lottery retailers will incur costs when they purchase lottery products from the Lottery for resale to their customer as described in rule 531—13.6. The same rule also describes retailer compensation for sale of lottery products to customers.

What are the costs to the agency or any other agency to implement/enforce the rule?

The agency incurs no cost to administer these rules beyond the costs envisioned by chapter 99G of the Iowa Code. Under section 99G.38, the Iowa Lottery is self-funded.

Do the costs justify the benefits achieved? Please explain.

Yes. As described above, a robust retailer network is central to the Iowa Lottery's mission to provide public entertainment and maximizing revenue while ensuring fairness and integrity. The partnership benefits both the Lottery and its retailer partners. While furthering those goals, these rules also promote the integrity of the Lottery's operations by outlining with clarity the obligations of retailers who choose to sell lottery products at retail.
