Registration for Self-Service Machine to Dispense Beer or Wine

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An owner or authorized representative of a retail alcohol license must complete and submit the registration for a self-service machine, along with the requested materials.

- Approval will not be granted without a properly completed application.
- Submission of a completed registration form does not guarantee approval.
- Registration approval only applies to licensed premises listed under Section 1.
- A new registration must be submitted prior to implementing any change to the operational plan or capacity of the machine.
- An application cannot be delegated to another entity.

SECTION 3: Iowa Law Compliance Monitoring

To use a self-service machine to dispense beer or wine, the retail alcohol licensee must review and agree to these requirements:

- 1. At the time of sale, the retail alcohol licensee, or licensee's employees, must determine the consumer is of legal age and is not intoxicated or simulating intoxication.
- 2. During operation, the retail licensee, or licensee's employees, must adequately monitor the self-service machine to prevent the sale or service of beer or wine to individuals who are under the legal drinking age or are intoxicated or simulating intoxication.
- 3. The sale of beer or wine, and the corresponding activation of the tracking technology to operate a selfservice machine must be conducted in-person by the licensee, or licensee's employees, directly interacting with the consumer and cannot be automated at the machine. This condition includes reactivation of an already-issued service card, wristband, or other token for further use by a consumer.
